

#2-The months away from school can result in a LARGE LOSS of knowledge in reading, math, science, and other core subject matter. Students in upcoming grades 1-4 (for the 2024-25 school year) can login through the CLEVER portal on WWW.AESLIBRARY.COM and keep up their reading, language, and math practice all summer between May 28th-July 31st (remember... your student's school Google login

information is written on the front page of his/her current school planner).

#3- All students who meet this **20-BOOK READING CHALLENGE** (OR 15 BOOKS IF AT LEAST 3 OF THEM ARE CHAPTER BOOKS 70 or more pages) in upcoming grades 1-4 will qualify for a SUPER-FUN REWARD!!! The reward will take place during the school day in the 2024-2025 school year (will be in October or November), and will be FREE for all qualifying grade 1-4 students.

In order to qualify, students must be **entering grades 1–4 (2023–24 school year)** and **MUST submit their SUMMER READING PROGRAM reading log from a public library** to Mrs. Ginn upon returning to school in August (HANDWRITTEN PARENT LOGS/NOTES WILL NOT QUALIFY). Any reading done in the MyON program must be done between <u>May 28th and June 30th (the data cutoff time is earlier this year)!</u>

Mrs. Ginn will run reports for reading practice through **M yON** to determine eligibility. *Any students entering kindergarten who meet the summer reading challenge will receive some cool prizes, but are not eligible for the reward day activity.
